

After the hearing period, we expect to be able to offer doctoral fellowships to the 6 top ranked candidates. If any of these candidates do not accept the offer, the fellowships will be offered, in succession, to the remaining candidates, according to the ranking above.

We expect to open a 2nd call for applications for AIM in early 2016.
